With November Win in Rear View Mirror, Rankey Begins Planning for Treasurer Job

DELAWARE, Ohio (Nov. XX, 2020) – Treasurer-elect Don Rankey was glad to put the Nov. 3 election in his rear-view mirror.

Now, the Republican has started planning for the day he assumes the office.

“While I just got elected, the truth is that I’ve been studying the operation of the county treasurer’s office for years,” Rankey said. “I believe there are ways it can be more efficient and a more effective tool for the county, particularly in the area of development. I’m looking forward to getting ahold of the reins.”

Because the treasurer’s office rotation aligns with the county’s fiscal year, Rankey won’t assume the office until September 2021.

It was the first time Rankey has run for public office. He ran unopposed.
